C A P. I. GENERAL PROVISIONS

Art . 1 Regulation of the organization and functioning of the student entrepreneurial society within the University of Life Sciences "King Mihai I" from Timisoara (ULST), developed in accordance with the provisions of the National Education Law no. 1/2011, updated and the M.E.N. Order no. 3262 of 16.02.2017, establishes the general principles of operation of the SES, its mission, organizational structure and attributions.

C A P . II. LEGAL STATUS AND MISSION

- **Article 2 (** 1) The student entrepreneurial society within ULST (hereinafter SES) is a structure without legal personality, established at the university level.
- (2) SES is subordinated academically to the university Senate and administratively to the rector.
- (3) SES represents a mechanism for supporting, developing and encouraging the entrepreneurial spirit in the university environment, especially among students and graduates of higher education, in order to increase the competitiveness of Romanian universities.

Art. 3 SES activity addresses:

- a) students from the University of Life Sciences "King Mihai I" from Timisoara, regardless of the study program they attend or the form of education, including students who come to study through mobility programs;
 - b) ULST graduates in the first 3 years after graduation.

CAP. III. POWERS

- **Art. 4** The student entrepreneurial society within ULST has the following main attributions:
- a) the development of materials intended to inform and guide students in the realization of business plans and/or financing projects, related to the fact that the possibility of the university educational system to produce in the medium term the skills required by the socio-economic environment is constantly changing;
- b) organizing mentoring activities for students who want to become entrepreneurs
- c) encouraging mentor-student collaboration in order to consolidate and develop some elements of the entrepreneurial skills necessary for future graduates at the level of higher education;

- d) organizing sessions to develop start-up projects, business ideas, etc., with the aim of selecting proposals to be submitted to the executive board for evaluation and feedback:
 - e) identifying and attracting financial resources to finance the best projects;
- f) the organization of periodic events through which the possibilities of accessing non-reimbursable financing are presented;
 - g) internships.

C A P. IV. THE ORGANIZATIONAL STRUCTURE

- **Art. 5** (1) SES is led by an Executive Council, approved by the University Senate with the following composition: president, vice president, secretary and members (teaching staff from ULST, tutors, local businessmen and students).
- (2) By decision of the university senate, the following can also be members of the Executive Council: representatives of local public authorities, employers, business incubators, as well as other representative entities for SES activity.
- (3) The executive council of the SES is led by a president, who must be a teaching staff member of the Council, elected by vote of the Council members and appointed by decision of the rector. The term of office of the president runs during the same period as the term of office of the rector, with the possibility of extension for one more term.
- (4) The President of the SES Executive Council presents to the Board of Administration and the University Senate a report on the annual activities, published on the website of the higher education institution.

C A P . V. FUNCTIONS OF THE EXECUTIVE COUNCIL

- A r t. 6 (1) The executive council meets quarterly, in ordinary sessions and in extraordinary sessions at the convocation of the president with the communication of the agenda of the meeting.
- (2) The executive council is legally constituted if half plus one of the number of members are present.
- (3) In the exercise of its powers, the Executive Council of the SES adopts its own decisions which are taken with the vote of the majority of the members present (simple majority) and are recorded in the minutes of the meeting which are signed by the president, vice-president and secretary.

A r t. 7 The President of the Executive Council has the following duties:

- a) convenes and presides over the SES Executive Council;
- b) ensures the implementation of the necessary decisions of the Council, and will inform the Council at the next meeting;
- c) represents the Council in the relationship with ULST and with the economic and business environment:
- d) administers all the actions of designing, organizing and carrying out the SES activity;
- e) presents to the Board of Administration and the University Senate a report on the annual activities of the SES, a report published on the ULST website;

- f) other duties that do not contravene the legal provisions.
- **Art. 8** (1) In establishing the annual plan of activities and in carrying out current activities, SES can collaborate both with student organizations legally established within ULST, with alumni structures, with counseling and career guidance centers, as well as with representatives of the entities representative for SES activity.
- (2) The President of the Board of Directors of the Excelsior Alumni Foundation is permanently invited to the meetings of the Executive Council of the SES.
- **Art. 9** The material base necessary for carrying out the activities is provided by USAMVBT.
- **Art. 10.** SES is financed through the university's consolidated budget, on the institutional development component. In order to ensure/develop SES activity, ULST can attract non-reimbursable funds and other extrabudgetary resources.

CAP. V. FINAL PROVISIONS

- **A r t . 11.** (1) The modification of the Organization and Operation Regulation of the SES is made upon the proposal of the Executive Council with the approval of the University Senate.
- (2) The regulation of organization and operation of the student entrepreneurial society within the Banat's University of Agricultural Sciences and Veterinary Medicine "King Mihai I of Romania" from Timisoara, was approved by the ULST Senate in the meeting of 31.10.2017.
